In an effort to keep the children, staff, and facility healthy, we ask that you keep your child home

under following conditions:

• Diarrhea (more than 6 times in the last 24 hours)

• Vomiting (2 or

more episodes in the last 24 hours)

- Temperature 100°+
- Ear Infection—while ear infections are not contagious, the upper respiratory infections that cause ear infections are. In addition, children are often very uncomfortable and cannot be cared for adequately while in the company of other children.
- Strep Throat—once a child has had 24 hours of antibiotics, he/ she is not contagious and may be brought back to class if he/she is feeling better.
- Chicken Pox—when pox marks are scabbed and dry, the child may return to the classroom.
- Pinkeye—24 hours of treatment before returning to class
- Impetigo—antibiotics 24-48 hours before returning to class

#### Absentee Policy

#### Admission

Children must be at least 9 months of age to enter the program. Parents must supply the following:



- 1. Current health and up-to-date immunization records for each child
- 2. Application/registration form.
- 3. Non-refundable registration fee of \$25 for church members and \$35 for non-church members, and first month's tuition as your deposit.

#### **Tuition**

Full-time monthly fees will be \$170 per month for all



classes (nursery thru Pre K). Parttime monthly fees will be \$85 per month. Bills will be sent at the beginning of each month. A late fee of \$2/day per child will be added to tuition fees after the 20th of each month. A \$25 fee will be added for all returned checks.

## Car Tags for Afternoon Pick-up

2 car tags will be issued per child. For security reasons, you are asked to display the tags that PDO provides and hang them from your rear view mirror. You will be charged \$1 each for additional signs.



#### Late Pick-Up Fees

The PDO hours of operation are from 9:00 a.m.—2:30 p.m. A fee of \$5 will charged beginning at 2:35 p.m. and \$1/minute added for every minute thereafter.
